Method of use:

Surface preparation:

Remove all grease, oil, dust, residual or other contaminant that could impair

adhesion. Laitance should preferably be removed.

Mixing:

Thoroughly stir Part A, add Part B and blend thoroughly using a slow speed mixer fitted with a suitable paddle till homogenous color is achieved.

Manual mixing is possible for small quantities.

Application:

Apply **Comtech Grout EP40 to** the spaces between tiles during working time the mixture using scraper or spatula directly into the joints and around the edges.

Remove surplus material from the face of the tiles with a dry cloth, it may be necessary to use small quantities of solvent to assist in the cleaning process.

Health and safety:

Comtech Grout EP40 does not classified in the hazardous materials; however it should not be allowed to come into prolonged contact with skin and eyes.

The normal safety precautions (hand gloves & safety goggles) are recommended for handling.
